zen masters of china presents more than 300 traditional zen stories and koans far more than any other collection retelling them in their proper place in zen s historical journey through chinese buddhist culture it also tells a larger story how in taking the first step east from india to china buddhism began to be zen the stories of zen are unlike any other writing religious or otherwise used for centuries by zen teachers as aids to bring about or deepen the experience of awakening they have a freshness that goes beyond religious practice and a mystery and authenticity that

appeal to a wide range of readers placed in chronological order these stories tell the story of zen itself how it traveled from west to east with each zen master to the next but also how it was transformed in that journey from an indian practice to something different in chinese buddhism ch'an and then more different still in japan zen the fact that its transmission was so human from teacher to student in a long chain from west to east meant that the cultures it passed through inevitably changed it zen masters of china is first and foremost a collection of mind bending zen stories and their wisdom more than that without academic pretensions or baggage it recounts the genealogy of zen buddhism in china and through koan and story illuminates how zen became what it is today

living and dying in zazen combines the life stories and teaching of five teachers kodo sawaki sodo yokoyama kozan kato motoko ikebe and uchiyama associated with antaiji monastery and the story of braver men and other western students coming to grips with zen japanese culture and themselves the deification of zen teachers by their followers has been a problematic issue in american zen this book provides a healthy antidote presenting four men and one woman who have lived and died in zen within the rich context of their personal lives and their culture so that we can fully understand what makes a zen master in japan

for more than four decades robert aitken roshi has taught thousands of people the buddhist practice of zen meditation and has led hundreds through their practice of the study of traditional koans he has authored more than a dozen books including a celebrated appreciation of basho's haiku volumes of commentary on sacred texts works on ethics daily life and social action and one of the best loved introductions to zen buddhism taking the path of zen after a long and remarkable life he will be 91 years old when this collection is published aitken roshi offers a collection of 266 short texts some are clearly parables others are simple stories quotations memories and commentaries resembling benjamin franklin's almanac or the epigrams of chamfort as much as it does work from ancient sages this collection of miniatures distills a life devoted to teaching and awareness any person living a considered life whether secular humanist or religious seeker will find this a book of rich inspiration

zen master's dance makes some of zen's subtlest teaching deeply personal and freshly accessible eihei dogen the thirteenth century japanese zen master of peerless depth and subtlety

heard the music of the universe that sounds as all events and places people things and spaces he experienced reality as a great dance moving through time coming to life in the thoughts and acts of all beings it is a most special dance the dance that the whole of reality is dancing with nothing left out all beings are dancing and reality is dancing as all beings in the zen master s dance jundo cohen takes us deep into the mind of master doogen and shows us how to join in the great and intimate dance of the universe through fresh translations and sparkling teaching cohen opens up for us a new way to read one of buddhism s most remarkable spiritual geniuses

instructions to the cook is a distillation of zen wisdom that can be used equally well as a manual on business or spiritual practice cooking or life the hardcover edition was featured in every major buddhist magazine be nourished and inspired magnificent work jon kabat zinn

extending their successful series of collections on zen buddhism heine and wright present a fifth volume on what may be the most important topic of all zen masters zen masters in china and later in korea and japan were among the cultural leaders of their times stories about their comportment and powers circulated widely throughout east asia in this volume ten leading zen scholars focus on the image of the zen master as it has been projected over the last millennium by the classic literature of this tradition

a collection of 124 chapters of eastern teachings containing the foundations of philosophy ancient wisdom and vision in an accessible way most chapters linked to buddhism hinduism and tao a book that encourages dialogue and personal research

here is the inimitable zen master seung sahn up close and personal in selections from the correspondence that was one of his primary modes of teaching seung sahn received hundreds of letters per month each of which he answered personally and some of the best of which are included here his frank and funny style familiar to readers of dropping ashes on the buddha is seen here in a most intimate form the beloved zen master not only answers questions on zen teaching and practice but applies an enlightened approach to problems with work relationships suffering and the teacher student relationship

zen masters of japan is the second book in a series that traces zen s profoundly historic journey

as it spread eastward from china and japan toward the united states following zen masters of china this book concentrates on zen s significant passage through japan more specifically it describes the lineage of the great teachers the zen monk pioneers who set out to enlighten an island ready for an inner transformation based on compassionate awareness while the existing buddhist establishment in japan met early zen pioneers like dogen and eisai with fervent resistance zen buddhism ultimately persevered and continued to become further transformed in its passage through japan the japanese culture and japanese buddhism practices further deepened and strengthened zen training by combining it with a variety of esoteric contemplative arts the arts of poetry the tea ceremony calligraphy and archery zen masters of japan chronicles this journey with each zen master profiled the book shows how the new practices soon gained popularity among all walks of life from the lowly peasant offering a hope of reincarnation and a better life to the samurai warrior due to its casual approach to death to the ruling classes challenging the intelligentsia because of its scholarly roots a collection of zen stories meditation and their wisdom zen masters of japan also explores the elusive state of no mind achieved in japan that is so fundamental to zen practices today

unlike most other formal religions the japanese school of zen buddhism has no canonized corpus of sacred literature which will reveal the truth to diligent readers there are however numerous collections of anecdotes and aphorisms that may serve to convey the sensibility which underscores the practice of zen drawing on these traditional sources dr irmgard schloegl of the buddhist society in london has gathered into one short volume a sampling of stories and sayings that are a valuable introduction to the study of zen if in every mind burns a flame of the buddha s enlightenment christmas humphreys writes in his foreword to the wisdom of the zen masters there is nothing to seek and nothing to acquire we are enlightened and all the words in the world will not give us what we already have the man of zen therefore is concerned with one thing only to become aware of what he already is the task of the japanese zen master has been to guide his pupils in their awakening the means used vary from severe physical discipline to the proposition of enigmatic riddles or koans but always to the same end enlightenment experiencing the great death of the worldly i

the sacred radiance of our original nature never darkens it has shined forth since beginningless

time do you wish to enter the gate that leads to this simply do not give rise to conceptual thinking zen master so sahn 1520 1604 is a towering figure in the history of korean zen in this treasure text he presents in simple yet beautiful language the core principles and teachings of zen each section opens with a quotation drawn from classical scriptures teachings and anecdotes followed by the author s commentary and verse originally written in chinese the text was translated into korean in the mid twentieth century by the celebrated korean monk boep joeng an american zen monk hyon gak has translated it into english

surprisingly little has been written about how zen came to north america zen master who does that and much more author james ishmael ford a renowned zen master in two lineages traces the tradition s history in asia looking at some of its most important figures the buddha himself and the handful of indian chinese and japanese masters who gave the zen school its shape it also outlines the challenges that occurred as zen became integrated into western consciousness and the state of zen in north america today the author includes profiles of modern zen teachers and institutions including d t suzuki and alan watts and such topics as the emergence of liberal buddhism and christians jews and zen this engaging accessible book is aimed at anyone interested in this tradition but who may not know how to start most importantly it clarifies a great and ancient tradition for the contemporary seeker

experience zen master thich nhat hanh s expressions of love connection and wisdom through deep and personal letters now published in english for the very first time widely recognized for his profound yet accessible teachings on the art of mindful living thich nhat hanh lived a rich life dedicated to fostering community and connection within and outside of the monastery walls in love and trust offers a striking look at thich nhat hanh as seen through his intimate letters to monastics lay practitioners allies in the peace movement and other friends on the path through these touching pieces of correspondence we see thich nhat hanh at his warmest and most inspirational at his most candid and direct these personal messages of love and trust demonstrate the deeply human origins of thich nhat hanh s teachings and his own deeply human expression of them in love and trust is composed primarily of newly translated letters presented here in english for the first time the book features images of archival hand written letters throughout

what motivated sodo san to spend the last twenty years of his life in a temple under the sky a

corner of a public park where he taught passersby what it means to be forever young through the funky tunes he played on his grass flute in the grass flute zen master sodo yokoyama we are seeking not only a truer understanding of this well loved monk but of zazen zen meditation itself in his search for insights into sodo yokoyama s life arthur braverman skillfully weaves a tapestry from seemingly disparate threads the brief taisho period into which sodo san was born and where individualism shone his teachers both ancient and contemporary practitioners of zen bhuddism the monk s love of baseball and the similarities braverman finds between sodo san and walt whitman who both found the universal in nature through conversations with joko shibata yokoyama s sole disciple and careful study of his teacher s poetry an intriguing tension between the personal and the universal is revealed the grass flute zen master is a meditative examination not of just one life but of many the lineage of teacher and prote ge is traced back through generations contemporaries are drawn up from unexpected places and braverman examines his own long journey in zen buddhism confronting his own expectations and surprising disappointments the monk lived in a boarding house and later took a cab to his park when he could no longer walk the whole way and the understanding and acceptance that followed when you play the leaf sodo san once wrote you ll usually be a little out of tune that s where its very charm lies

the classic samurai era text that fused japanese swordsmanship with zen philosophy written by the incomparable zen master takuan soho written by the seventeenth century zen master takuan soho 1573 1645 the unfettered mind is a book of advice on swordsmanship and the cultivation of right mind and intention it was written as a guide for the samurai yagyu munenori who was a great swordsman and rival to the legendary miyamoto musashi takuan was a giant in the history of zen he was also a gardener calligrapher poet author adviser to samurai and shoguns and a pivotal figure in zen painting he was known for his brilliance and acerbic wit in these succinct and pointed essays takuan is concerned primarily with understanding and refining the mind both generally and when faced with conflict the unfettered mind was a major influence on the classic manifestos on swordsmanship that came after it including miyamoto musashi s book of five rings and yagyu munenori s life giving sword

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daisetz teitaro suzuki's the training of the zen buddhist monk invites you to step inside the mysterious world of the zendo where monks live their lives in simplicity this is perhaps the best introduction to zen and the life of the zen monk by means of a direct and succinct description of the training that a zen buddhist monk undergoes dr suzuki has given us the most precise picture possible of zen in life the forty three illustrations give a unique value to the book the artist zenchu sato has depicted here the record of his own experiences in going through all the disciplinary measures pertaining to the life of zen as author dr suzuki said zen ought to be studied not only in its theoretical aspects as a unique product of the oriental mind but in its practical aspect as it is to be seen in the zendo life this is the chief motive for my writing this book

zen is famous for koans called kong an in korean and in this book those bizarre and seemingly unanswerable questions zen masters pose to their students to check their realization such as what is the sound of one hand clapping fear of koans keeps some people from ever giving zen practice a try but here through the experience of seeing a modern zen master work with his students you can see what koan training is really like it's a skillful lively practice for attaining wisdom this book presents the system of ten koans that zen master seung sahn came to call the ten gates these koans represent the basic types one will encounter in any course of study each of the ten gates or koans is illuminated by actual interchanges between zen master seung sahn and his students that show what the practice is all about it is above all a process of coming to trust one's own wisdom and of manifesting that wisdom in every koan like situation life presents us with for more information on the author zen master seung sahn visit his website at [kwanumzen.com](http://kwanumzen.com)

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
